Webelos Scouts will compete against other Webelos Scouts for the Webelos traveling trophy. Webelos must also pre-register.

Cubs, other than Webelos may attend with the cost of \$5.00 which will include a patch and lunch. Cubs will observe, but not compete. Cubs should also pre-register, to let us know how many will be attending.

You will be required to make a snow sculpture of some type. You will be allotted 20 minutes to complete the sculpture and it will be judged as to size, looks, and originality. Food coloring may be used if desired (not provided).

Every Scout must have boots (no shoes allowed), a winter hat, and two pair of gloves. Check the weather before leaving for the derby to see if each scout should bring a rain coat or not.

Each patrol will be given a score sheet to take from station to station and must be turned in as soon as the last station is completed.

Driving Directions: Take US 31 North until you get to Pellston. At the corner by the BP Station and Pellston General Store turn left on Robinson Road then proceed about two hundred yards and Pioneer Park is on the left. Signs will be at the corner of US 31 and Robinson Road and at the Park Entrance.

Registration at the event will be open from 8:00 AM until 9:00 AM Saturday morning. During registration the unit will be asked to provide a list of both youth and adults who are attending the event along with the appropriate health forms (Part A&B). Please plan to register as soon as your unit has gotten settled.
