The jobs connected with patrol meals in camp boil down to three areas: Fuel and Water, Cooking, and Clean Up. Assignment of responsibilities is based on the buddy system. All patrol members "buddy up" on the jobs while the Patrol Leader is free of regular assignment so he can give a hand where needed making sure everything gets done. Assignments change after each meal. The Scout at the top of the list goes to the bottom of the list and everyone else moves up one slot, getting a new buddy for the meal.

**PATROL LEADER:** Gets patrol together and lines up the first meal buddies. Makes sure all the Scouts know responsibilities they will have. Assigns buddies to duties making sure jobs are adjusted fairly. Keep the system flexible to get the job done.

**FUEL AND WATER BUDDIES:** Maintain water supply. Keep supplies of tinder, kindling, and charcoal protected from weather. Start fires in time for cooks to have meals ready on time.

**COOKING BUDDIES:** Assemble food supplies, follow menus and recipes exactly, serve meals on time, put away food, put cook pots to soak, have cleanup water supply on fire before serving meals. Say grace before eating.

**CLEANUP BUDDIES:** Set up wash and rinse water for dish-washing, clean cooking pots and utensils, cleanup the kitchen and dining areas, store all patrol equipment. Dispose of garbage, trash, and dishwasher in the proper places. Put out fire.
