Wood Badge is the most advanced level of leadership training for adults in the Boy Scouts of America. Wood Badge brings together leaders from Cub Scouting, Boy Scouting, and Venturing, as well as district and council volunteers. It is focused on developing leadership skills; every Scouter can benefit from Wood Badge.

The skills learned here will apply to your Scouting role, and every other role in your life. The Wood Badge curriculum is equal to or better than most corporate leadership development programs. Some of the skills that will be covered are communicating, team development, project planning, problem solving, conflict management, and learning the greatest secret of leadership.

Dates: Orientation: August 14
Weekend I: August 20 – August 22
Weekend II: August 27 – August 29

Weekends will begin Fri morning and conclude Sun afternoon.

Qualifications: You must be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America, at least 18 years of age.
